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Ammonia Code of Practice Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC) Audit Process Modifications

Certification under the Ammonia Code of Practice (Code) requires an audit to be completed by a certified auditor every 2 years. Between certification re-auditing, the Code Senior Auditor may conduct a QA/QC or a 'spot' audit to verify that the conditions of certification are being met. The QA/QC audits have typically been conducted during the busy season when implementaion of code requirements and operational practices can be best verified. In order to help facilitate a timely QA/QC audit, the audit checklist has been reduced to focus on key aspects of normal business practices.

The Canadian Fertilizer Institute (CFI) stongly encourages Code certificate holders to cooperate with the Senior Auditor during the QA/QC audit process and to provide requested material in a timely manner. Working with your Senior Auditor will ensure the speediness of the audit so that the certificate holder can get back to business.

QA/QC audits demonstrate that industry best practices are being implemented and that our employees, our customers and our communities can rely on their local businesses to keep them safe. Through this exercise, we are able to demonstrate the fertilizer sector's commitment to the safe and secure storage, handling and transportation of ammonia fertilizer and that we continue to raise the bar on how we do business.
