Fertilizer Canada Celebrates Canadian Ag Safety Week

(Ottawa, ON) - Fertilizer Canada is celebrating Canadian Agricultural Safety Week (CASW) 2017 by promoting the safe and secure handling and use of fertilizer products through multiple eLearning courses geared towards industry workers and first responders.

"Fertilizer Canada is committed to promoting agriculture safety during Canadian Agricultural Safety Week and year round," said Garth Whyte, President and CEO of Fertilizer Canada. "Our eLearning courses provide the tools necessary to ensure industry professionals have the knowledge to use fertilizer products effectively and safely."

Canadian Agricultural Safety Week (CASW) is an annual public awareness campaign focusing on the importance of farm safety. Under the three-year theme of "Be an AgSafe Family," this year organizers are "Appealing to Adults" and asking all farm safety champions to work together to improve safety on Canadian farms.

Although the campaign lasts for only a week, farm safety is important all year around. That's why organizers have made available free online resources that farmers can access and use on their operation any time of year.

"We all want to see Canadian farms be safe and productive," says Marcel Hacault, Executive Director of the Canadian Agricultural Safety Association. "Ag Safety Week is an opportunity for farmers, community leaders and organizers to appeal to the adults in their lives and show their commitment to farm safety."

Fertilizer Canada has developed more than 20 eLearning courses on a range of topics available for farmers and other industry workers, including first repsonders. The courses cover a range of topics, including: the safe and secure storage of various fertilizer products, first-responder training for incidents involving anhydrous ammonia and driver fatigue training for fertilizer product transporters.

This year, CASW organizers have published free resources that can help producers achieve their goal of a safe and productive farming operation. These resources include information about creating a general policy statement, toolbox talks and a women's health series.
