## Ontario Agri-Retailers Continue to Demonstrate Commitment to 4R Nutrient Stewardship

Additional five sites become 4R Certified, including:

Since 2018, the 4R Certification program has worked with over 2,400 farmers. 4R practices have been implemented on approximately 600,000 certified acres, which accounts for 6.5% of Ontario's total cropland.



Twenty-three agri-retail facilities are 4R Certified, which means they have aligned their business practices with the sustainability principles of 4R Nutrient Stewardship, as verified by 37 auditable standards.
